

STUDENT AGREEMENT

Dance is a beautiful art form and a fun pastime, however it is also a physically demanding discipline. While we strive to make class activities as accessible and safe as we possibly can, we cannot guarantee against the risk of injury that may occur during class, rehearsal, or performance. By registering for and participating in a Sundance offering, the student accepts responsibility for their own physical health and safety, and will hold Sundance Studios & Productions harmless in the event of injury or accident.

Some factors that help decrease the likelihood of injury include maintaining proper hydration and nutrition, a regular practice of stretching and strengthening exercises, and getting plenty of rest when not in rehearsal.

Rules and Regulations

- 1. Students are expected to be present and on-time for class and rehearsal, particularly during performance season. Unless in a case of emergency, discuss any and all absences beforehand with your class instructor.
- **2.** Students are expected to leave their cell phones, homework, and other possible distractions in the designated area with their belongings during class time.
- **3.** There may be times in class when students will be in physical contact with one another. Particularly for partnering and lifting, it is very important that we approach this contact with respect and wait for acknowledgment and consent before proceeding with rehearsal. This is not an invitation to engage in horseplay: in general, if it is not part of the instructions, students should keep their bodies to themselves.
- **4.** Each Sundance instructor may set expectations specific to their classes that may not be reflected in this list. It is expected of the students to follow such regulations.
- 5. Sundance Students taking class in the Bath County location at the Bath Community Wellness & Rehab Center are expected to abide by the following rules in order to keep a positive relationship with and respect the facilities of the Bath Community Wellness & Rehab center:

- Sundance Students are not permitted to be within Bath Community Rehab & Wellness Center without the supervision of a Sundance Staff member, unless they are members of the gym themselves.
- Sundance Students are not permitted to touch or use the equipment of Bath Community Rehab & Wellness Center unless they are members of the gym themselves.
- Bath Community Rehab and Wellness Center is not liable for any injury or accident that may occur on their premises, whether during a Sundance class offering or otherwise. Registration for a Sundance class is separate from membership of BCRWC.
- We are so pleased and thankful to be hosted by the Bath Community Rehab and Wellness Center. In order to continue our positive relationship, it's important to be respectful of the boundaries between these separate entities, as well as any rules or regulations of BCRWC.
- **Our Bath studio is located** within the Bath Community Rehab & Wellness Center in Mitchelltown at 9247 Sam Snead Hwy
- When coming to the studio, please DO NOT use the main entrance of Bath Community Rehab & Wellness. Instead, please enter through the side door on the right side of the building. It will lead directly to the studio space.
- If you need to get in contact with Sundance Studios & Productions, please **DO NOT** call Bath Community Rehab & Wellness Center
- Registration for and participation in classes offered by Sundance Studios and Productions **DOES NOT** give the student access to Bath Community Rehab & Wellness Center's greater facility, equipment, classes, or other services.

6. PAYMENTS & CLASS FEES:

- Students registering online will be required to submit their class fees by mail to: Sundance Studios & Productions, P.O. Box 571, Monterey, VA 24465
- Students registering in-person or at a Sundance Open House will be required to pay their class fees at the time of registration.
- All class fees are due by the 10th of each month or a \$5 late fee will be added.
- **7.** Only students acknowledging and committing to this agreement will be eligible to attend classes at Sundance Studios & Productions.
